He is currently a government-appointed member of the Board of Directors of the General Health Insurance Fund of the Czech Republic and the Military Health Insurance Fund. He served as a member and, from 2020, as the Chair of the Conciliation Panel of the Audit Board, which deals with the final settlement of disputed international healthcare claims.

He is also a researcher on the FLASH project, which addresses legal and practical barriers to healthcare provision in border regions with differing price levels, particularly along the Czech-German and Czech-Austrian borders.
