Anke Boone is a researcher working on her Phd 'WeMeds: Healthy & Work-engaged Doctors' at the Centre for Environment and Health at KU Leuven in the research group of Prof. Dr. Lode Godderis. Her research investigates the evolution of burnout during medical education, assesses its main determinants, and identifies interventions that aim to prevent burnout. Further, she coordinated the EU-funded project 'Meteor: a focus on job retention of healthcare workers', which enhanced the scientific knowledge on job retention of healthcare workers in Europe and developed policy recommendations to increase job retention for this occupational group. In addition to these two projects, she is involved in various other projects related to mental health, well-being, and burnout, often with a focus on healthcare professionals.
