Is also a steering group member of the Moving Fourth Initiative focused on providing practical tools and recommendations in HIV care. And is also a member of NLO (Nobody Left Outside) initiative focused on access to healthcare by underserved populations in the wider health sector. As an HIV activist and member of NPS Italia, has contributed to the implementation of a Hepatitis C elimination plan in Italy (March 2017).
