

Dimopoulos, Christos

Christos Dimopoulos is the Manager of Protection and Integration Projects of the Doctors of the World - Greek Delegation. His target group is the most vulnerable groups of the population, such as migrants, refugees (especially UAMs), homeless people, etc.

Since the beginning of his career, in 2000, Christos Dimopoulos worked both at public organisations and NGOs, focusing on migration issues. Since 2006 he worked as a social worker in Metaxourgeio, the district of Athens where the majority of migrants arriving in the city used to live.

In 2012 working for the National Centre for the Social Solidarity, he created the Service for the Accommodation of Asylum Seekers and Unaccompanied Minors, where he worked as the Head of the department until 2016.

In the last two years, Christos Dimopoulos is working strongly on creating new tools and methodologies concerning the participation of Asylum Seekers and Unaccompanied Minors in the decision making procedures.
