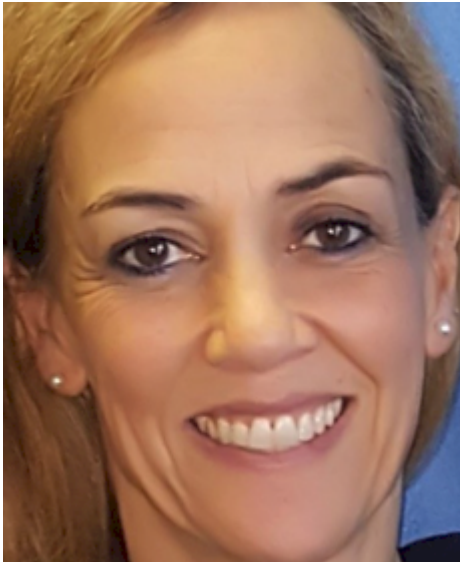


Ferreira Borges, Ana Carina

Dr Ferreira-Borges is the Programme Manager for Alcohol, Illicit Drugs and Prison Health at WHO/Europe, and is based at the NCD Office, in Moscow. She worked as an addiction counsellor from 1992 to 2002, becoming the director of a Treatment Center in 1996. She obtained her Master's degree in Public Health in 2002 and a PhD in International Health in 2015 with Nova University in Lisbon. From 2006 to 2014 she was in charge of the Unit for Alcohol and Substance Abuse at the WHO Regional Office for Africa, where she provided support for country implementation of evidence-based, comprehensive national policies, and until joining the WHO European Office for NCDs in December 2017, she worked as an international public health consultant providing strategic consultancy on public health issues around the world. She has authored several books on addiction, and articles on alcohol policies in peer-reviewed journals; she has also contributed to several WHO publications and collaborated in the development of research initiatives in areas such as Screening and Brief Interventions, FASD and Harm to Others.
