Francesca Moccia is Deputy Secretary General of Cittadinanzattiva, an organization, founded in Italy in 1978, which promotes citizens' activism for the protection of rights, the care of common goods, the support for people in conditions of weakness in Italy. Cittadinanzattiva operates daily also at the European level since December 2001 thanks to its EU branch called "Active Citizenship Network" (ACN). Trained as a lawyer and specialized in International Protection of Human Rights, she gained her experience especially in the field of health protection and was the national coordinator of the Tribunal for patient's rights. For some years she directed the Civic Evaluation Agency of Cittadinanzattiva, working to spread the Civic Audit of public policies and services. She is a member of the Board of Directors of FONDACA, the scientific committee of Next Nuova Economia and the ASviS working group on Goal 3 Health.

She is also a member of the Forum on Inequality and Diversity, an alliance of active citizens' organizations and researchers aimed at producing and disseminating research, policy proposals and "methods for decision making" which can enhance social and environmental justice, defined as sustainable substantive freedom.
