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Holm Graessner is a clinician-scientific strategist and research leader whose multidisciplinary background spans biomedical engineering, cybernetics, electrical engineering, German language and literature, philosophy, and business administration. He received his PhD summa cum laude in 2004 and an MBA in 2008.

Since 2010, he has been Managing Director of the Centre for Rare Diseases at the University and University Hospital Tübingen. He coordinates the European Reference Network for Rare Neurological Diseases, co-led the Horizon 2020 Solve-RD project, and co-leads the Clinical Research Network of the European Rare Diseases Research Alliance. He is also a founding member of the European 1 Mutation 1 Medicine initiative and a Board member of the global N-of-1 Collaborative.

A Fellow of the European Academy of Neurology since 2020, he joined the Lancet Commission on Rare Diseases in 2025. In 2023, he received the EURORDIS Black Pearl Award for Leadership and the inaugural Martha and Wilfried Ensinger Award.
