Raffael Heiss is a postdoctoral researcher at the Management Center Innsbruck (MCI) and a founding member of the MCI Center for Social & Health Innovation. Previously, he was a PhD candidate and uni:docs fellow at the Department of Communication, University of Vienna. He is the project leader of the Covid-19 Social Indicator Survey, a panel survey which investigates media use, attitudes & behaviors and knowledge patterns during the Covid-19 epidemic in Austria. His general research interests include political & health communication, dis- and misinformation in digital media and civic engagement. He has also conducted multiple projects in the field of citizen science and advocates public participation in science. His research has appeared in some of the most important journals in communication, such as "Political Communication", "New Media & Society" or "Communication Research".
