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Mark Hellowell is Senior Lecturer (Associate Professor) in Health Policy at the University of Edinburgh, with expertise in health financing, governance, strategic purchasing, capital investment, and public-private partnerships. Since 2022, much of his work has focused on Ukraine, where he has supported WHO and partners on health system recovery, health-care infrastructure planning, and the governance of the Program of Medical Guarantees. His recent work examines how, in a wartime context, emergency response, recovery, and reform can be connected, with particular attention to sustaining access to care, strengthening strategic purchasing, improving investment appraisal, and ensuring that reconstruction supports long-term health system transformation.
