Dr Anette Hulth has worked as coordinator at the Public Health Agency of Sweden since 2014, leading the agency's collaborations on antimicrobial resistance (AMR) and infection control in the EU and internationally. For 1.5 years, she was seconded to the Swedish Ministry of Health to contribute to the political declaration on AMR, adopted by the UN General Assembly in October 2024. She is a collaborator in the EU Joint Action on AMR (EU-JAMRAI 2) and a national representative in the EU AMR One Health Network. She has been part of the WHO Collaborating Centre on AMR containment at the Public Health Agency since its designation in 2016. Dr Hulth has a PhD in computer science. Before entering the field of antibiotics, she developed and implemented applications for syndromic surveillance and automatic outbreak detection.
