Dr. Marija Jakubauskienė is a public health expert, researcher and academic leader currently serving as the Minister of Health of the Republic of Lithuania. Dr. Jakubauskienė brings to the role more than two decades of experience in public health science, biomedical research, medical humanities and health policy development.

Dr. Jakubauskienė holds a PhD in Biomedical Sciences from Vilnius University, where additionally earned MBA in Entrepreneurship. The Minister held a number of senior academic positions, including Associate Professor and Director of the Institute of Health Sciences at Vilnius University's Faculty of Medicine. Dr. Jakubauskienė leadership has extended to international engagement as Vice-Dean for International Affairs and Programmes and played an active role in advancing public mental health through her contributions to the European Public Health Association (EUDHA), where served as President of the Public Mental Health Section and as a member of the International Scientific Committee. Marija's research interests included population health science, mental health, health system, policy research and medical humanities.
