Sabine Kampmüller is the Director of AFYA, which she founded in 2017. The non-profit organisation aims to promote (mental) health of refugees and migrants in Vienna, with innovative, low-threshold programmes.

Sabine holds a degree in International Health (MIH) and Paediatric nursing. She has worked for Médecins sans Frontières (MSF) from 1996 – 2016. She worked as a field nurse in South Sudan, Nagorno Karabagh, Kenya and Uganda, and as the Head of Human Resources in MSF Austria. In 2005 she founded the MSF Evaluation Unit in Vienna and became a leading expert for organisation-wide learning, accountability and incident management.

As a lecturer she has been teaching Qualitative Health research, Transcultural nursing, Public Health and more recently Trauma-sensitivity in education and social work.

Sabine is a Member of the Austrian Public Health Association (ÖGPH) and of MSF.
