Prior to her role on HELP Committee, Jenelle worked at the State Department on developing and advancing the U.S. policy in the areas of health, science, technology, and the environment with countries/organizations across the globe.

Jenelle completed her pediatric clinical psychology residency/post-doctoral fellowship at Brown Medical School where she conducted research supported by the NIH in the areas of childhood obesity and tobacco policy.
