Dr. Jenelle Krishnamoorthy is the Associate Vice President for Global Policy, Communications and Population Health at MSD and is trained as a licensed clinical psychologist. Jenelle heads the global therapeutics teams responsible for developing policy on all MSD medicines and vaccines. Prior to joining MSD in January 2015, Jenelle was the Health Policy Director for the Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (HELP) Committee and led the health team in the United States Senate for Chairman Harkin. Dr. Krishnamoorthy first joined Chairman Harkin's team as an American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) Fellow in 2003 and 2004. During 2004 and 2005 Jenelle worked at the U.S. State Department in the Bureau of South Asian Affairs on health, science, technology, and environment issues with India on an AAAS Diplomacy Fellowship.

Early in her career, Jenelle completed her pediatric clinical psychology internship and post-doctoral fellowship at Brown Medical School where she conducted research in the areas of childhood obesity and tobacco issues. Dr. Krishnamoorthy received her B.S. from Randolph-Macon College, M.S. from the University of Tennessee and her Ph.D. from Virginia Commonwealth University.
