Lisa Lehner is a health researcher and health systems expert at the University of Vienna where she currently co-leads a WWTF-funded project on the prescription and use of antibiotics and benzodiazepines in Vienna, as well as smaller projects on health literacy and healthcare access for systemically marginalized communities. She is also an affiliated member of the “Community Health Lab” at the Medical University of Vienna and Health Programs Director at the NGO AmberMed (Diakonie Refugee Services), which provides medical care to people without health insurance in Austria. In her work, she focuses on issues of social justice, health equity, and healthcare access. She also teaches at different national and international universities on medical ethics, marginalization, and diversity. Lisa is a member of the Young Forum Gastein initiative, and has received Young Gastein scholarships in 2022, 2023 and 2024.
