Alison Maassen is Senior Coordinator at EuroHealthNet, and responsible for supporting the Director in overseeing the development and implementation of EuroHealthNet's programming, including its tasks as a part of the Joint Action CHRODIS PLUS. In coordination with CHRODIS PLUS WP4 leaders, ISCIII, as well as national organisers, EuroHealthNet led the planning and execution of fourteen national and two EU-level CHRODIS PLUS policy dialogues. Alison has significant experience in project and association management, as well as experience in designing and implementing health promotion interventions at the community level. Prior to joining EuroHealthNet, she worked extensively in the field of immunisation, serving as Programme Manager for the Network for Education and Support in Immunisation at the University of Antwerp, and as a founding member of the Secretariat for the International Association of Immunization Managers (now the Boost Community) at the Sabin Vaccine Institute in Washington DC. Alison holds an MSc in Public Health (Health Promotion) from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, as well as a BA in International Affairs and Anthropology from The George Washington University in Washington DC. She has worked at the global and (sub)national level with policy makers, health professionals, community leaders, researchers, and other stakeholders from regions as diverse as Latin America, the Middle East and North Africa, and Southeast Asia.
