Nicole is a Technical Officer based at the European Observatory on Health Systems and Policies in Brussels. Her work focuses on innovation, evidence-informed health policy and health systems in Europe.

Before joining the Observatory, she worked as a Blue Book Trainee at the European Commission's Directorate General for Health and Food Safety (DG SANTE), where her work focused on health information and the State of Health in the EU cycle. She has also worked as a Scientific Officer at the Robert Koch Institute in Berlin.

Nicole holds a Medical Degree from the University of Milan, Italy. In 2020, she was awarded a doctoral scholarship at the Heidelberg Institute of Global Health (Heidelberg Graduate School of Global Health), Germany, where she is currently completing her doctoral studies with a focus on hypertension management in low- and middle-income countries. Results from her project were recently published in Science Translational Medicine. She is also studying for a master's degree in Public Health at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, UK.

Nicole's research and professional interests include health policy and systems research at European and global level, social determinants of health, health system innovation and change. She is attending Gastein for the first time this year, both as a speaker and as a Young Gasteiner.
