Wolfgang Mückstein was appointed Federal Minister of Social Affairs, Health, Care and Consumer Protection in April 2021. Minister Mückstein has over a decade of experience in the medical field, having worked as a general practitioner in Vienna since 2007, and has been a representative of the Vienna Medical Association. As an expert on group practices and new organizational forms, he established the first Primary Health Care Unit in Austria in 2015. Minister Mückstein was also involved with a number of other initiatives like the Neunerhaus project which provides medical care, housing and counselling to homeless people, and has worked for the mobile emergency medical service.
