

Mustonen, PasiPermanent Representation of Finland to the EU



Pasi Mustonen has worked as Counsellor responsible for health policy issues, including pharmaceuticals, at the Permanent Representation of Finland to the European Union since 1st October 2016. During Finland's Presidency of the Council of the EU in 2019, Mustonen chairs the Council Working Party on Public Health. Before relocating to Brussels he was based in Geneva as Health Counsellor at the Permanent Mission of Finland to the United Nations and other international organizations, covering relations to the World Health Organization (WHO) and UNAIDS. Between 2009 and 2014 Mustonen held different positions at the Ministry of Social Affairs and Health in Helsinki focusing on EU and international affairs. He has also worked at the Legal Department of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs and at the Energy Department of the Ministry of Employment and the Economy. Mustonen holds a degree of Master of Laws from the University of Helsinki with a special focus on public international law.
