

Narbutas, Šarunas

Šarunas Narbutas is a professional lawyer, strategic consultant and a patient advocate, who is living with chronic myelogenous leukemia (CML) for more than 12 years. In the past 5 years, he has participated as a patient advocate speaker / moderator in over 300 high-level conferences throughout Europe and has led a debate on cancer-related issues at the national level and in front of European authorities. He holds various management positions in national and international patient organisations, has served on dozen governmental committees or working groups. Until 2017, Šarunas Narbutas has also served as a political advisor to the President of the Republic of Lithuania. Before joining the President's team in 2014, Mr. Narbutas was a member of an Advisory Board of Lithuanian Minister of Health. In 2017 Šarunas became a board member at National e-Health Management Board, was elected Chairman of Governmental Fund on Public Health, became a member of "National Health Council" and a Board Member at "Invest Lithuania, where he is responsible for the promotion of Life Sciences ecosystem. Since 2013 he is acting as a President of "Lithuanian Cancer Patient Coalition" (POLA), is a Co-Founder of "Youth Cancer Europe" and a Chairman of "CML Advocates Network". In his previous roles he has also served as a member of a Lithuanian reimbursement committee and also as a deputy chair of the commission awarding damages to patients caused by a medical mal-practice, while also being involved in dozens of governmental working groups and co-developing m.Health and e.Health solutions. He has been delivering lectures in Vilnius University Faculty of Law on Health Law, Tech Law and European Union Law.
