Francesco Negro is Professor at the Departments of Specialty Medicine and of Pathology and Immunology of the University of Geneva, Switzerland. His research interests focus on viral hepatitis, especially on the pathogenesis of metabolic alterations induced by the hepatitis C virus, i.e. steatosis and insulin resistance. More recently, he has participated into several collaborative works on epidemiology and public health issues related to viral hepatitis. He has participated in several clinical trials in acute and chronic HCV, authoring or co-authoring ~300 peer-reviewed manuscripts in the field of hepatology. After serving for three years as Educational Councilor within the Governing Board of the European Association for the Study of the Liver (EASL), he is now Treasurer-elect of the same Board. He is Co-Editor of Liver International, Chairman of the Swiss Hepatitis C Cohort Study, and member of the updating committees of the clinical practice guidelines for HCV of the EASL and the World Health Organisation.
