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Dr. Graziano Onder, MD, PhD, is a geriatrician with a long history of experience in the field of chronic diseases and elderly care. He is currently Director of the Department of Cardiovascular, Endocrine-metabolic Diseases and Aging at the Italian National Institute of Health (Istituto Superiore di Sanità). Dr. Onder has previously worked as Research Associate at the J. Paul Sticht Center on Aging, Wake Forest University, Winston Salem, NC, USA (2001-2002) and as Associate Professor at the Department of Geriatrics of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, Rome, Italy (2002-2019).
