

Privarova, Miriam

Coming from Slovakia, Miriam Privarova works as a Junior Professional Associate at the World Bank within the Environment, Natural Resources and the Blue Economy [Global Practice](#). She is managing the Bank's Environmental and Social Framework portfolio for Europe and Central Asia. Previously, Miriam worked as a consultant at the OECD Environment Directorate. Miriam holds a BA degree in the trilingual program of Social Sciences from SciencesPo Paris and a Dual Master degree in International Public Management at SciencesPo Paris and in European Studies at King's College London. As the first Slovak ever, Miriam was selected in 2020 to lead the delegation of the European Union to Youth20 which is one of the official engagement groups of G20, working on pro-youth policy recommendations for G20 leaders. In 2021, Miriam volunteered as a Global Youth Climate Ambassador and was also selected as an official Youth4Climate delegate of Slovakia having pitched with other delegates a climate action roadmap for Pre-COP26 & COP26 at the Youth4Climate Driving Ambition event.
