Klaus Ropin, PhD has been responsible for developing and overseeing the field of Workplace Health Promotion at the Austrian Health Promotion Fund (FGÖ) since 2001. Networking and cooperation with stakeholders in workplace health promotion across Austria, with a particular focus on quality assurance and the further development and wider implementation of workplace health promotion, have been key elements of his work. His responsibilities as a health promotion specialist have also included lecturing at institutions such as IMC Krems, Pinkafeld University of Applied Sciences and university-level Public Health programmes.

Since March 2014, he has been managing director of the FGÖ. Following his work as a research associate at the University of Graz, Ropin gained professional experience in quality assurance and prevention in hospital hygiene at the Styrian Hospital Association, and subsequently in the Prevention Department of AIDS-Hilfe Wien, where he established a programme focusing on prevention tailored to specific occupational groups.
