His professional career brought him to managerial positions in various major Slovenian companies, including Mercator, Petrol, and Semenarna Ljubljana. From 1st January 2018 until his nomination as minister, he served as the general manager at the largest public health care institution in Slovenia, the Ljubljana University Medical Centre, where he organised work, prepared the operational and financial plan, drew up basic business policies and financial restructuring, and participated in negotiations with various stakeholders.
