Dr. Quentin Sandifer OBE has practiced public health for more than three decades. Between 2012 and 2020 he served as executive director for public health services and medical director at Public Health Wales leading the directorate responsible for the provision of national screening programmes, health protection and microbiology services, and public health emergency planning and response for the population of Wales. In 2020, he served as the strategic director for Public Health Wales' response to COVID-19. From 2014 to 2020 he was the executive lead representing Public Health Wales in IANPHI and in 2019 became the first chair of the IANPHI Europe regional network. In 2021 he was appointed as a strategic adviser to the IANPHI Executive Board. After retiring from Public Health Wales in December 2020, he returned in 2021 as a consultant adviser on pandemic and international Health. In 2021 he was appointed an Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire (OBE) for services to public health.
