Maurizio Scarpa, MD, PhD, is Founder and President of Brains for Brain Clinical Research Institute, a European task force on brain and neurodegenerative lysosomal storage disorders (LSDs). He is also Director of the Institute for Rare Diseases at the Department of Paediatrics of the Horst Schmidt Klinik in Wiesbaden, Germany and Professor of Pediatrics at the Department for the Health of Woman and Children at the University of Padova, Italy.

Maurizio Scarpa is the Coordinator of the European Reference Network for Hereditary Metabolic Diseases (MetabERN), formed by 69 health care professionals in 18 EU countries and treating 43,000 metabolic patients, and he is the Chair of the ERN Coordinators Working Group.

Prof. Scarpa has extensive expertise as a scientist in genetics and biotechnology, as well as a clinician in the diagnosis and treatment of paediatric rare disorders, LSDs, and neurometabolic diseases. He is especially interested in developing diagnostic assays and new approaches for the treatment of LSDs.

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
