

Schmit, Nicolas



Nicolas Schmit is a Luxembourgish politician who served as European Commissioner for Jobs and Social Rights from 2019 to 2024. A member of the Luxembourg Socialist Workers' Party (LSAP), he was the EU-wide Spitzenkandidat of the centre-left PES at the 2024 EU elections.

Nicolas Schmit was member of the government of Luxembourg from 2004 to 2019, first as Minister Delegate for Foreign Affairs and Immigration and from 2009 to 2018 as Minister for Labour and Employment. He served as Member of the European Parliament in 2019 for the social-democratic Lëtzebuerger Sozialistesch Aarbechterpartei following his election in May 2019, before taking on his role as European Commissioner in December 2019. Nicolas Schmit holds a Doctorate in International Economic Relations and a Masters in French Literature from the University of Aix-Marseille.
