Kristoffer Strålin is an Infectious Diseases physician at Karolinska University Hospital and an Associate Professor at the Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm, Sweden. He is the chairman of the Swedish National Program Area for Infectious Diseases at Sweden's Regions in Collaboration.

Since 2019, Strålin is the chairman of the National action group for sepsis. This multidisciplinary group has built up a sepsis healthcare process, which is focused on sepsis identification and patient follow-up, with the aim to improve sepsis care and make it more equal in Sweden. This health care process has been approved by the Swedish healthcare directors and is currently being implemented into Swedish healthcare. Currently, Strålin leads the development of an electronic system aimed to monitor the sepsis healthcare process population electronically.
