As Co-ordinating Advisor of International Affairs she is currently based at the National Institute for Public Health and the Environment (RIVM), the Netherlands. Previous posts included work on European policy and health systems research at the Nuffield Institute for Health in Leeds (UK), the co-ordination of cross-national efforts on integrated local HIV/AIDS policies for WHO Europe, and international affairs at the Netherlands Institute for Care and Welfare. Nicoline is president of EuroHealthNet.
