Paola Testori Coggi is Special Advisor of the National Technological Cluster on Life Sciences Alisei. She is Member of the Italian Delegation to Horizon Europe-Cluster Health Programme Committee and she is Lead Co-Chair of the T20 Italy Task Force on Global health and Covid-19. She is Ambassador of the Federated Innovation at MIND - Milano Innovation District. She teaches EU Health policy at the Master Studies of the European College of Parma. Paola Testori Coggi spent much of her career within the European Commission where she was Director General for Health and Consumers (DG SANTE) until 2014. She entered the Commission in 1983 in the environmental sector and held various posts in the area of health, food safety, consumer protection and research. Among her achievements in the Commission were the legislation on cross-border health care and on pharmaceuticals and medical devices, and the promotion of health as an investment for growth, the White Paper on food safety, and the creation of the European Food Safety Authority. After having returned to Italy, she worked for the Ministry of Health as President of the Price and Reimbursement Committee of the Italian Medicines Agency from 2015 until September 2018. Paola Testori Coggi has been Chair of the Valletta Technical Committee on cooperation for better access to medicines. She also cooperates with the International Trade Center of the United Nations as Special Advisor on sanitary and phytosanitary matters. Paola Testori Coggi is a biologist from the University of Milan, Italy, with a Master degree in Ecotoxicology. In 2008, she received a Doctor Honoris Causa in Veterinary Medicine at the University of Cluj, Romania and in 2010 she was awarded the Official Cross of Merit of the Italian Republic.
