Viktoriia worked closely on the development and approval of the National drug strategy for Ukraine from 2015 to 2020, advocating for more balanced and human-rights oriented policies and practices in Ukraine. Mrs. Tymoshevska was engaged in establishing expert body for health technology assessment, national essential medical list, its set up and review that now is the founding instrument for the Ukraine's reimbursement program and medicines that are used in the Program of Medical Guarantees. Viktoriia's recent professional interest includes organization and delivery of the medical services to the communities that are close to the front line. Another field of professional interest is reform of military medicine system and ensuring protection of human rights and dignity through support of policy making and capacity building of key stakeholders.
