Vlad Voiculescu has been a Member of the European Parliament since July 2024. He is Renew Europe's coordinator in the Committee on Public Health (SANT), the Vice-Chair of the delegation for relations with the ASEAN countries, and the co-chair of the European Parliament's Intergroup on Cancer and Rare Diseases. He serves as the Parliament's rapporteur for the implementation report on Europe's Beating Cancer Plan and his work on that file centres on measurable outcomes, prevention, and addressing the survival gap across Member States, alongside simpler cross-border access to specialised treatment.

Before entering the European Parliament, Vlad Voiculescu fought for nearly two decades to get patients the care and medicines they need, work that has taken him from patient advocacy to twice serving as Romania's Minister of Health. In 2008, he built an international network of hundreds of volunteers that got essential, otherwise unavailable medicines into the hands of thousands of cancer patients. He went on to found MagiCAMP, a non-profit supporting seriously ill children and their families across Romania, Moldova and beyond. For his work, the European Parliament awarded him in 2018 the "European Citizen's Prize".
