Liisa-Maria Voipio-Pulkki is DG of Strategic Affairs and Chief Medical Officer (CMO) at the Finnish Ministry of Social Affairs and Health, where she heads the Management Support Unit.

Voipio-Pulkki previously worked as Director of the Unit for Health Services at the Department for Social and Health Services since 2010. On 1 September 2017, she took up the position of Director of the Department for Wellbeing and Services. Among her other duties, Voipio-Pulkki has also served as chief administrative physician at the Association of Finnish Local and Regional Authorities, being responsible for expert duties relating to the administration and development of healthcare and social welfare. Voipio-Pulkki holds the degree of Doctor of Medicine and Surgery.

The Management Support Unit (JOT) assists and supports the Permanent Secretary's activities in the preparation of objectives for the Ministry and its administrative sector and in the development, implementation and monitoring of wide-ranging issues, such as strategy processes. The unit also supports the development of the Ministry's activities and the coordination of the duties of the Ministry's departments and units.
