Introduction

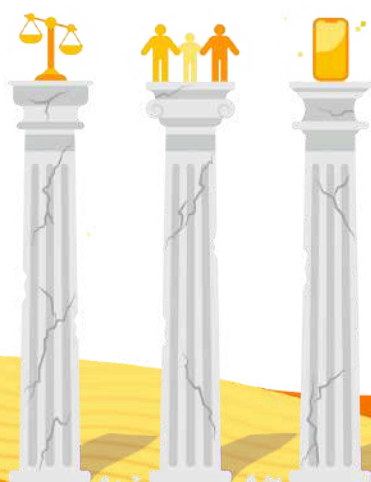
The 27th European Health Forum Gastein (EHFG), held under the theme “Shifting sands of health: democracy, demographics, digitalisation”, brought the European health community together to discuss the challenges facing Europe. The conference was co-organised by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Social Affairs, Health, Care and Consumer Protection, with support from the European Union, and in collaboration with the World Health Organization Regional Office for Europe.

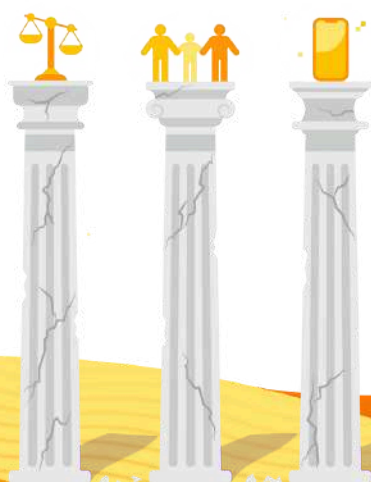

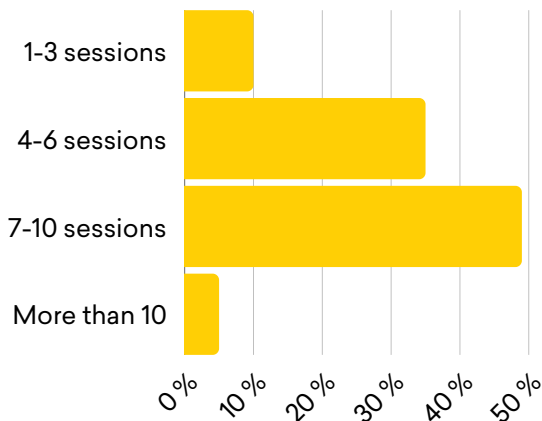

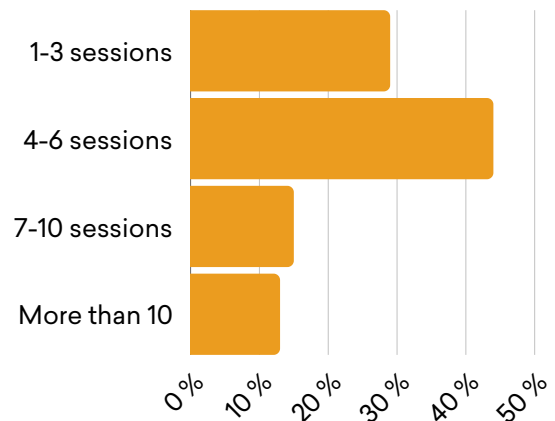

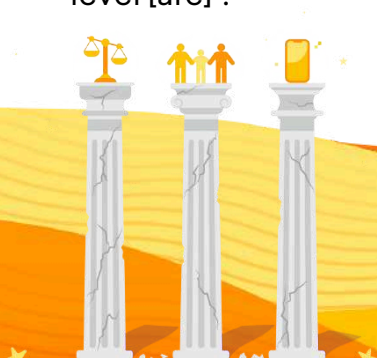
EHFG 2024 takeaway messages
