INTRODUCTION

EuroNet MRPH stands for the **European Network of Medical Residents in Public Health**. We are an independent network of national associations of public health residents and residency programmes around Europe.

At EuroNet MRPH, we aim to share information on residency programmes, facilitate internships and common activities, as well as to develop a body of scientific research.

The idea of a network of European associations **first emerged in 2008** when French and Italian residents started a collaboration on a project exploring the satisfaction of residency programs in the two countries.

Since then we have grown to include **9 member associations** representing more than 2.000 resident physicians and trainees in public health. Besides national member associations, we also have **individual members** from three European countries (figure 1).

THAT'S HOW WE ROLL

Our work focuses around three pillars of EuroNet MRPH: **networking**, **research** and **internships**.

Connecting public health residents

- Monthly teleconference meetings.
- **3 EuroNet meetings each year.**
- Specific workshops and educational events.

We have formed **partnerships** with:

- **European public health organisations**
Association of Schools of Public Health in the European Region, European Public Health Association, EUPHANxt and European Public Health Alliance.
- **Global health organisations**
Child Family Health International.
- **Non-European residents' networks**
Public Health Physicians of Canada and the South African Public Health Medicine Association.

Pan-European relevant research

Each member can propose, lead and/or get involved in one of our **Working Groups** (figure 2).

- We have helped residents across Europe to carry out their research projects by providing information through signposting.
- Several activities and working groups that we developed have been focused on **improving the quality and homogeneity of public health training programmes across Europe.**
- We have created the **Euronet Platform**, an online platform that will help researchers across Europe to create public health research projects.

Facilitating international mobility

- **More than 50 EuroNet-specific internship positions** in national and international institutions covering a wide range of public health topics.
- In the last three years, we have processed **64 applications** from **34 residents** requesting an internship in 6 different countries.
- We **have recently increased the offer of internship positions**, including:
 - *World Federation of Public Health Associations;*
 - *EuroHealthNet;*
 - *International Consortium for Health Outcomes Measurement.*
