## TASK 3: Interview

### TASK DESCRIPTION

Your task is to identify and interview key figures who can answer questions about healthcare in Europe. Please aim for two-three interviews per working group from across the different sessions to which your group has been assigned to.

### PREPARATION

- Bring any recording device which can be used to record an interview, a laptop, photo cameras/smartphones (optional)
- Get familiar with the work of the interviewee, as well as his or her participation/input at the Conference

### REQUIREMENTS

Ask in advance for the interviewee's **authorisation** to publish online his or her interview as well as photograph/video/audio recording.

### FORMATTING

- Think of a **snappy title**
- Name and last name of the interviewee, his or her position
- One introductory sentence / scene setter, describing the interviewees (the reason why you chose them), and their activity at the EHFG
- Questions starting with your initials, **all in Bold** (initials and the question)
- Answers starting with the interviewee initials, **only initials in Bold**
- A photo or a short video of the interviewee, **with prior interviewee's authorisation**
- Your name(s), title(s), position, country you come from

### HOW TO PROCEED WITH THE TEXT OF THE INTERVIEW?

- Send the draft interview to the interviewee for the authorisation to publish it
- Send it to the EHFG to feature it on our website/blog/social media sites throughout the year
- Approach online or print publications which may be interested in publishing your interview
- Make a brief summary (max 600 words) of the interview during the conference to post as a blog on our EHFG blog site ([www.ehfg.org/blog](http://www.ehfg.org/blog))
- Choose one key statement from the interview and submit it as a proposition for the "Disruption Lounge", or get it on Twitter (or both);

- Approach one of the Young Gasteiners in charge of the daily newsletter to feature a part of the interview in the newsletter.

## TASK DISTRIBUTION

Depending on the work distribution within the group, the interview can be conducted by 1-3 people.

This is to be set at the Group meeting.
